D. 434-50, a man of high social station, who, in A. D. 441, attended the first Council of Orange; and it is addressed to Faustinus, a priest of the monastery of Insula Barba. Whether Eucherius be the author or not, there can be no doubt that the Epitome was written before it had become the fashion to stimulate the devotion of pilgrims by the exhibition of relics connected with our Lord s Passion. It is impossible to assign an exact date to the tract, but the fact that only two churches are mentioned in connection with the Mount of Olives, whilst Theodosius (A. D. 530) mentions two basilicas and twenty-four churches, indicates that it belongs to the earlier and not to the later series of itineraries. Antoninus Martyr (A. D. 570) also alludes to many monasteries and places where miracles had been performed on...
